**RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SETTING
COMPENSATION FOR THE SEPARATED OFFICE OF AUDITOR-CONTROLLER AND
TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has adopted Resolution No. 24-105 which sets forth the salaries, terms of conditions of employment for all Elected Department Heads; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors to amend said resolution to meet the needs of County service; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2025, the Board of Supervisors approved Ordinance Separating the offices of the Auditor-Controller, Treasurer-Tax Collector, into the office of Auditor-Controller and the office of Treasurer-Tax Collector, effective January 2027; and

WHEREAS, the Elected Auditor-Controller and Elected Treasurer-Tax Collector will be two separate positions, effective January 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the below compensation for Auditor-Controller and Treasurer-Tax Collector as follows:
