



MASTER FEE SCHEDULE

- Policy 47
 - The Executive Office Prepares Updated Fees
 - Per Board direction, fees were evaluated for full cost recovery
 - Significant update to the Master Fee Schedule
 - Increase in fees of over \$3.3 million
 - Future Priorities



FEE REVENUES

The proposed Master Fee Schedule includes:

- An increase of over \$1.7 million in General Fund revenues
- An increase of over \$1.5 million in non-General Fund Revenues.



SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

• The largest increases occurred in:

- Planning and Building Services-Over \$1.3 million in new revenue (General Fund)
- Environmental Health-Over \$1.4 million in new revenue (non-General Fund)



FUTURE PRIORITIES

- Work with County Counsel to update ordinances to seek full cost recovery on applicable fees that have State limits
 - Some fees have limits set by the State-with an ordinance update, many of these fees can be increased to meet full cost recovery
 - Continue to review and update the Master Fee Schedule to reflect any updates in costs for labor and general expenses
