RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UKIAH TO SUBMIT A CALRECYCLE BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING CITY/COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM REGIONAL APPLICATION, AS LEAD PARTICIPANT, ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO (COUNTYWIDE)

WHEREAS, the California Public Resources Code authorizes the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various Payment Programs; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of Payment Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program allows regional participation; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle Payment Program application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle Payment Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorizes the City of Ukiah to submit a CalRecycle Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program Regional application as Lead Participant on behalf of County of Mendocino.

Be it further resolved that the City of Ukiah is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of County of Mendocino all Payment Program-related documents necessary to implement and close out the programs.

Be it further resolved that these authorizations are effective for five years from the date of adoption of this Resolution.
