RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REQUESTING THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT ITS PERMISSION FOR THE GUALALA LIONS CLUB LIGHTED TRUCK PARADE IN GUALALA, CA PURSUANT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL'S JOING POLICY GUIDELINES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS ON STATE CONVENTIONAL HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAYS
