NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the Item may be heard, to be held in Saint Anthony's Church, 10700 Lansing Street, Mendocino, California, will conduct a public hearing on the following Local Coastal Program Amendment.

REQUEST/SUMMARY: Consider proposed amendment of the Mendocino County Local Coastal Program to add Chapters 20.537 and 20.538 to the Coastal Zoning Code regulating Coastal Cannabis Cultivation and Coastal Cannabis Facilities and corresponding changes to Mendocino County Code Chapters 10A.17 and 6.36 to add references to the proposed new Chapters 20.537 and 20.538. The chapter regarding Coastal Cannabis Cultivation will govern activities related to the cultivation of cannabis and establish limitations on the location and intensity of cannabis cultivation in the unincorporated area of Mendocino County within the Coastal Zone Area. The chapter regarding Coastal Cannabis Facilities will regulate land use and zoning to ensure that the scale of processing, manufacturing, restailing/dispensing and distribution of cannabis is compatible with the County's land use and environmental setting, establish permit requirements for cannabis businesses and require compliance with environmental and public health regulations. These chapters are intended to complement a variety of actions by the State of California to establish a legal framework for cannabis cultivation and businesses.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Statutorily Exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15265

LOCATION: Within the unincorporated areas of Mendocino County located inside the Coastal Zone boundary (Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division II), excluding the Town of Mendocino (Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division III).

PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION: The Planning Commission, at their July 18, 2019 meeting, adopted a resolution making a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that they authorize submittal of a Local Coastal Program Amendment application for OA_2019-0001 to the California Coastal Commission for certification and approve the Project by adopting an ordinance amending Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division II, to add Chapters 20.537 and 20.538, and amending Chapters 10A.17 and 6.36 of the Mendocino County Code to add references to the proposed new Chapters 20.537 and 20.538, with modifications made at the meeting and as specified in their resolution.
