RE: INTRODUCE AND WAIVE READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15.04.030 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE – SPEED ZONING ON COUNTY ROADS, ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT(S) BETWEEN 25 MILES PER HOUR (MPH) AND 40 MPH ON VARIOUS SEGMENTS OF LITTLE RIVER AIRPORT & ALBION RIDGE ROADS, COUNTY ROADS (CR) 404 MILEPOST (MP) 0.00 TO 5.92 AND CR 402 MP 0.00 TO 4.00 (LITTLE RIVER - ALBION AREA)


Traffic Study No. 25-01 was undertaken at the direction of the Road Commissioner in response to requests from California Highway Patrol (CHP) to make existing speed zones enforceable using their radar/lidar speed measurement system along Albion Ridge and Little River Airport County Roads (CR) 402 and 404 respective.

By Resolution Number (No.) 25-082 (May 6, 2025) the Board accepted Traffic Study Nos. 25-01, recommending the establishment of a twenty-five miles per hour speed limit on Little River Airport Road (CR 404), from milepost 5.00 to milepost 5.92 and establishing a forty miles per hour speed limit on Little River Airport Road (CR 404), from milepost 1.85 to milepost 5.00 and also on Albion Ridge Road (CR 402), from milepost 1.00 to milepost 4.00 intersection with Middle Ridge Road. This change caused an increase of 5 mph over existing posting on some road segments.

The Department of Transportation is herewith submitting an Ordinance for the Board's consideration to accomplish the speed zone changes recommended by Traffic Study No. 25-01.
