RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD, FOR AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED; PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED ESTIMATE OF \$516,000 INCREASED TO \$1,104,000, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 160078 TO CONSTRUCT THE LAYTONVILLE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE OVER TEN MILE CREEK ON BRANSCOMB ROAD, COUNTY ROAD 429 (LAYTONVILLE AREA)

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (DOT) desires to construct a multi-use pedestrian bridge over Ten Mile Creek on Branscomb Road, County Road (CR) 429, alongside the existing vehicle bridge; and

WHEREAS, funding to accommodate the original estimated construction costs of \$516,000 was budgeted through Budget Unit 3041 Fiscal Year (FY) 2016/17 and FY 2017/18); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number (No.) 16-142, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Director of Transportation to advertise for bids and to award DOT Contract No. 160078 for up to the estimated amount of \$516,000; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bidder was Bridgeway Civil Constructors, Inc., with a bid of \$723,347; and

WHEREAS, DOT rejected all bids and researched alternatives to reduce construction costs; and

WHEREAS, due to increases in construction costs, DOT now estimates the cost to construct a bridge on Branscomb Road to be \$1,104,000 and are anticipated to be funded with Federal Transportation Enhancement Activities funds administered through the State Transportation Improvement Plan, Mendocino Council of Governments funds, and the Road Fund (including Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account); and

WHEREAS, under Section 20395 of the California Public Contract Code, the Board of Supervisors may authorize the Director of Transportation to execute contract change orders subject to certain cost limitations; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 07-008, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Director of Transportation to execute changes to any DOT contract that exceeds \$250,000 by up to \$25,000, plus 5% of the amount of the original contract costs in excess of \$250,000, and in no event shall any change or alteration exceed \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation recommends proceeding with advertisement for bids and award of contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors hereby:

- Authorizes and directs the Director of Transportation, to sign the Notice to Bidders inviting bids for DOT Contract No. 160078 to construct the Laytonville Pedestrian Bridge over Ten Mile Creek on Branscomb Road, CR 429; and
- 2. Authorizes and directs the Director of Transportation to award DOT Contract No. 160078 upon confirmation of an appropriate low bidder, for the amount not to exceed \$1,104,000 to construct the Laytonville Pedestrian Bridge over Ten Mile Creek on Branscomb Road, CR 429, and process contract documents acceptable to County Counsel and Risk Management; and report the results to the Board through the applicable Director's Report.
