Thank you for taking so much time & care to work out cannabis policy for our county. I live in Laytonville and as we currently have no representation on the BOS, I would like to ask you to consider the special nature of our community. Because there are so few jobs in our area, cannabis has become the main financial support of our town. This is not just the large growers in the hills (many of whom come from out of the area to grow) but local small Mom & Pop growers who live in the valley. I live near the lake where most of my neighbors grow some cannabis either for personal use or to supplement their income. We all live on one acre parcels. PLEASE consider us when you vote on policy today. Would it be possible to allow gardens on less than 2 acres if we get permission from our neighbors? Or create some sort of plan for communities like ours that is relatively easy to implement? The zone layover thing looks complicated & difficult. When you all first started to create a plan, I thought one of your goals was to protect the small Mom & Pop grows, but it looks like you've completely left us out of the current plan.
