

TO: WalMart; Mendocino County Board of Supervisors,

I am 69, and still recovering from bronchitis, so I am taking every precaution to avoid getting Covid-19. I use InstaCart to do my grocery shopping from Safeway in Willits, but still no TP or hand sanitizer available! None on Amazon either. So, even though I've been "sheltering in place" as recommended, I ventured out to Ukiah, a half-hour drive south. On 3/27/20, I put on my mask, grabbed my Clorox Wipes and hand sanitizer, and marched into Walmart in Ukiah, California.

I was **shocked** to see a crowded store but no one practicing the 6-foot-distance rule! No one was enforcing the 6-foot rule in check out lines either. There was no hand sanitizer, or Isopropyl Alcohol to make my own. I was allotted only one package of TP and one of Kleenex, which will necessitate yet another trip into the breeding ground of Walmart in a couple of weeks.

I am really concerned about the public ignorance apparent in Walmart. As an employer, Walmart should be protecting both employees and the public from the spread of Covid-19. They are breeding ground and will cause an explosion of the virus here. This would be unfortunate, since our rural county only has 4 cases right now.
