NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors at their regular meeting on Tuesday, March 12, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the item may be heard, located in the Board of supervisors Chambers, County Administration Center, 501 Low County Gap Road, Ukiah, California, will conduct a public hearing to re-view the performance of Grant No. 12-CDBG-8399, funded through the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Funding was used for microenterprise technical assistance, direct technical assistance, direct homebuyer's assistance, an eco-nomic development planning study, a housing condition plan-ning study, ADA improvements to a ramp in the Town of Mendocino, acquisition of land and rehabilitation of a building to be used as a homeless shelto be used as a homeless shel-ter, Willits Veteran Hall ADA accessibility improvements, Mill Creek Fishing Platform ADA improvements, and Sun House apartments public improve-ments. All of the projects have been completed, and a total of \$982,311 grant funds was dis-bursed, and a total of \$1,952,819 in CDBG Program Income funds were used, as required by State policy.
