Due to a new opportunity, and the results of re-evaluating our Wildland Fire equipment needs, we request a change to our proposed list to accommodate the following item

We have been seeking for a few years a replacement to our aging Type 3 fire engine. Finally, after extensive research, we have found a newer used type 3 engine that exceeds our expectations and one that will serve our community for many years.

The funds from the PGE Settlement agreement, \$45,454.44 plus monies from our Volunteer Fire Department saving account will cover the purchase cost. The Department's small savings account is the results of years of funding raising events plus donations for just this purpose.
