Accomplishment Narrative With support from HCD's CDBG-CV 2 & 3, the County of Mendocino completed Phase II of the Live Oak Apartment project, which provides transitional and permanent housing for individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness throughout the county. This project finalized the conversion of a 56-room motel into a 49-unit apartment building consisting of studio units of about 300 square feet each. Each unit is furnished with one or two beds, a dresser, table, kitchenette, and a bathroom. Six of the units have adjoining rooms which provide two-room units for families with children. Four of the units are fully-ADA accessible and are suitable for residents in a wheelchair. The second phase specifically addressed the renovation of 23 rooms and additional improvements included upgraded flooring, sidewalk enhancements, a new perimeter fence, and a gazebo. The County followed HCD procurement protocols to issue bids, enter into construction agreements, and complete work within 6 months. Tenants began moving into the renovated floor of the facility on November 11, 2022.
