## **EXHIBIT A**

## MCHID MANAGEMENT DISTRICT PLAN SUMMARY

Location: The proposed MCHID includes all businesses licensed as general acute care

hospitals by the California Department of Public Health located within the

boundary of Mendocino County ("Hospitals"), as shown on the following map.

Services: The MCHID is designed to provide specific benefits directly to the Hospitals by

providing additional resources to support the Hospitals' provision of healthcare

services to low-income and needy members of the community.

Budget: The total MCHID annual budget for the initial year of its five- (5-) year operation

will be based on a percentage set by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors ("Board"), multiped by the Hospitals' net patient revenue. Assuming a six percent (6%) assessment rate, the annual budget using the Hospitals' recent net patient

revenue amounts would be approximately \$20,000,000.

Cost: The annual assessment rate will be set by the Board.

Collection: Mendocino County will collect the assessment (including any delinquencies,

penalties and interest) from the Hospitals.

Duration: The proposed MCHID will have a five- (5-) year life, beginning July 1, 2024

through June 30, 2029. Once per year, beginning on the anniversary of MCHID formation, there is a thirty- (30-) day period in which owners paying fifty percent (50%) or more of the assessment may protest and initiate a Board hearing on


MCHID termination.

Management: Consistent with the discretion provided to the County by Property and Business

Improvement District Law of 1994, Streets and Highways Code section 36651

permits, the proposed MCHID will be governed directly by the Board.
