**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the item may be heard, to be held in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah, California, will conduct a public hearing on the following Ordinance Amendment .

**APPLICANT:** COUNTY OF MENDOCINO

**REQUEST:** Consider proposed amendments to Mendocino County Code Chapter 10A.17 - Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance, and Chapter 20.242 - Cannabis Cultivation Sites. Multiple changes are proposed, including transferability of permits, reducing the minimum parcel size for nurseries from 10 to 5 acres, extending the phaseout of generators, providing for a limited extension of the Phase One Sunset Provision for Residential Districts, modifying the types of permits that may be applied for during Phase Two, and postponing the start of Phase Three until July 1, 2020.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Addendum to adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration

**LOCATION:** Within the unincorporated areas of Mendocino County, not including the designated Coastal Zone areas of the County.

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** All

**PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:** The Planning Commission, at their August 15, 2019 meeting, adopted a resolution recommending that the Board of Supervisors approve Ordinance Amendment No. OA\_2019-0002, which will make amendments to Chapters 10A.17 and 20.242 of the Mendocino County Code, with modifications as specified in their resolution.

**SUMMARY:** This ordinance is making several amendments to various sections of County Code Chapter 10A.17 - Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance and Chapter 20.242 - Cannabis Cultivation Sites regarding the County's cannabis cultivation permit requirements. Proposed amendments include providing for transferability of permits, reduction of the minimum parcel size for nurseries, removal of the prohibition on visibility of plants from a public right of way or publicly traveled private road, extension of the generator phase-out, limited extension of the Phase One Sunset Provision for Residential Districts, modification to the types of permits that may be applied for during Phase Two, and postponement of the start of Phase Three until July 1, 2020.

The staff report, notice and draft ordinance will be available for public review 10 days prior to the hearing at 860 North Bush Street, Ukiah, California and on the Department of Planning and Building Services Website at <https://www.mendocinocounty.org/government/planning-building-services/public-notices>

Your comments regarding the above project are invited. Written comments should be submitted to the Clerk of the Board at 501 Low Gap Road, Room 1010, Ukiah, California no later than September 9, 2019. Oral comments may be presented to the Board of Supervisors during the public hearing.

The Board of Supervisors action shall be final. If you challenge the project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors or the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing. All persons are invited to appear and present testimony in this matter.
