

ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.04.190 OF TITLE 3 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE - HOLIDAYS

This Ordinance amends Mendocino County Code section 3.04.190 to replace the County's Columbus Day holiday with Indigenous People's Day. The Ordinance also makes a few style changes, updates, and corrections

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on September 10, 2019.
