Attended meeting of Ukiah Main St. businesses on 4/12. Conversation about the opening of the California Welcome Center in the Ukiah Convention Center.

Mendocino County Museum's Strategic Plan is being fine-tuned. We had a working session and fine tuned the draft. This should be submitted to the BoS in the latter part of May. Willits City Council will be submitting a letter to the BoS requesting that the Bittenbender Family donation of \$500,000 not be used for anything except for the betterment of the museum. This is also the recommendation of the Museum Advisory Board and this Supervisor.

Attended the CSAC Board of Directors meeting on 4/13.

General Government Standing Committee had a special meeting on 4/14 to go over recommendations to streamline the cannabis ordinance. This meeting focused on issues that would not have environmental impacts. Mostly the issues were administrative functions that were duplicative of state functions. The interactions between the Committee, staff, and public were positive and productive. The regular General Government Standing Committee met on 4/17. The main item was the Mendocino Cannabis Department report. Implementation of the program was of general interest. With the new administration, people were feeling that progress was being made on a variety of fronts.

Great Redwood Trail Agency meeting on 4/20 in Healdsburg. Review of community outreach sessions in Fortuna and Willits as well as many other small, more focused groups. I recommended that special attention be paid to landowners along the Eel River Canyon and other remote areas. They, along with first responders, have many concerns. There is a commitment by staff to outreach to these people.
