RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 250003 CASPAR LANDFILL VEGETATION MANAGEMENT FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$105,000 (MENDOCINO AREA)

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (DOT) has been conducting vegetation management activities at the Caspar Landfill through a contract since 2020; and

WHEREAS, post-closure maintenance standards for disposal sites contain vegetation maintenance requirements for the landfill vegetative cover layer; and

WHEREAS, control of vegetation further facilitates landfill inspections, helps to control the establishment and spread of noxious and invasive weeds, and provides fuel load reduction for fire safety; and

WHEREAS, DOT will prepare and administer specifications and contract documents for DOT Contract Number (No.) 250003 Caspar Landfill vegetation management for a period of three years at an estimated cost of \$105,000; and

WHEREAS, fifty percent of the annual costs will be reimbursed from the City of Fort Bragg through an existing Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) for maintenance of the jointly-owned landfill; and

WHEREAS, funding to accommodate contract costs is available in Landfill Closure Fund and has been budgeted in Budget Unit 4511 (Landfill Closure) in Fiscal Year 24/25; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation recommends proceeding with advertisement for bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors hereby:

 Authorizes the Director of Transportation to sign the Notice to Bidders inviting bids for DOT Contract No. 250003 for Caspar Landfill vegetation management for a period of three years; and
