

**REQUEST:** General Plan Amendment to update the Housing Element for the County of Mendocino as required by State law (Section 65580 - 65583 of the California Government Code). The 2019-2027 Housing Element identifies residential sites adequate to accommodate a variety of housing types for all income levels and needs of special population groups defined under State law (Section 65583 of the California Government Code), analyzes governmental constraints to housing maintenance, improvement and development and outlines policies to promote housing opportunities for all persons.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Addendum to the previously adopted County of Mendocino General Plan Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (State Clearinghouse No. 2008062074).

**LOCATION:** All unincorporated areas within Mendocino County, excluding those areas within the City limits of Ukiah, Fort Bragg, Willits and Point Arena.

**SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT:** All

**STAFF PLANNER:** JESSE DAVIS

**PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:** The Planning Commission, at their October 17, 2019 meeting, adopted a resolution recommending that the Board of Supervisors adopt General Plan Amendment No. GP\_2019-0004, the 2019-2027 Housing Element, and adopt the addendum to the General Plan EIR related thereto.

**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOMMENDATION:** On December 10, 2019, the Board of Supervisors voted 4-1 to adopt the Draft Housing Element via Resolution 2019-2027. This allowed staff to submit the Draft Housing Element after including requested changes to HCD as part of the certification process. Upon HCD certification, staff would return to the Board of Supervisors with a finalized 2019-2027 Housing Element for their review and adoption.

All written public comment received by 5:00 A.M. the day of the hearing will be made available to the Supervisors, staff, and the general public as posted by Clerk of the Board staff, and can be viewed as attachments to this meeting agenda at <https://mendocino.legistar.com/Calendar.aspx>.

The Board of Supervisors' action shall be final. If you challenge the project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Department of Planning and Building Services/Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing. All persons are invited to appear and present testimony in this matter.
