RE: ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO EXECUTE THE PROJECT DELIVERY AGREEMENT FOR THE SEISMIC RETROFIT OF THE GARCIA RIVER BRIDGE ON EUREKA HILL ROAD, COUNTY ROAD 505, MILEPOST 4.92, AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO SIGN ANY AND ALL AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT (POINT ARENA AREA)

Honorable Board Members:

The Garcia River Bridge on Eureka Hill Road is a seismically deficient bridge which is eligible for a retrofit with funding from the Highway Bridge Program (HBP) and State money set aside for seismic retrofits under the Local Bridge Seismic Retrofit Account (LBSRA). This road is the only road that serves the private residences at the end of Eureka Hill Road.

The California Transportation Commission (CTC) is requiring Project Delivery Agreements from all agencies for any remaining seismic retrofit projects. These Project Delivery Agreements establish a timeline for project completion and need to be approved by the governing body. The Mendocino County Department of Transportation is requesting authority for the Director of Transportation to sign this agreement along with any and all amendments that may come about, in order to avoid any delays in approval of funding by the CTC. The project is nearly ready to advertise and is anticipated to be constructed in the summer of 2021.

The HBP will cover 80% of the preliminary engineering costs with the local match funded through the LBSRA, and 100% of the right of way and construction costs.
