

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MODIFYING REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR THE REMOVAL OF FIRE DEBRIS FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY FOLLOWING THE REDWOOD COMPLEX FIRE

The urgency ordinance seeks to protect the environment and the public health by establishing a coordinated and consistent approach to cleaning up and removing the fire debris and ash from the Redwood Complex Fire. The ordinance modifies the Ordinance No. 4398, which requires all property owners choosing the private cleanup program, or who are otherwise ineligible for the public cleanup program, to meet certain standards, such as submitting a written plan prior to debris removal. Ordinance No. 4398 requires property owners in the private cleanup program to complete all work by the later of February 1, 2018 or the date that the certificate of remediation for the final property in the public cleanup program is issued. This ordinance would change the deadline for the private cleanup program to a date certain of March 1, 2018.

The ordinance contains findings establishing the urgency of the ordinance as required by Government Code section 25131.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on Tuesday, February 27, 2018.
