RE: ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ELEVENTH AMENDMENT TO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AGREEMENT NUMBER 11-056/DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT NUMBER 110002 FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES WITH CONSOR NORTH AMERICA, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$239,400, FOR A NEW CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$1,691,900, FOR THE ACKERMAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON NORTH STATE STREET, COUNTY ROAD 104, MILEPOST 0.94 (UKIAH AREA)

## Honorable Board Members:

The Department of Transportation (DOT) respectfully requests the Board's approval of the attached Resolution authorizing execution of the eleventh amendment to BOS Agreement Number (No.) 11-056/DOT Agreement No. 110002 with Consor North America, Inc. (Consor). The proposed amendment increases the contract amount by \$239,400, for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$1,691,900.

This project is replacing the functionally obsolete Ackerman Creek Bridge on North State Street, County Road 104 at milepost 0.97. The current amendment addresses additional work necessary during construction, including coordination with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) related to fishway design changes required by CDFW and associated hydraulic modeling and plan revisions.

The proposed services are detailed in Exhibit A of the amendment. Consor has agreed to complete the work for the not-to-exceed amount of \$239,400.

The project is funded primarily (88.53%) through the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Highway Bridge Program (HBP). The local match (11.47%) is funded through a combination of Mendocino College grant funds, State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funds, Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) funds, and the Road Fund.

I recommend and request the Board of Supervisors approve the eleventh amendment to BOS Agreement No. 11-056/DOT Agreement No. 110002 for professional engineering services related to the Ackerman Creek Bridge Replacement Project on North State Street and authorize the Director of Transportation or his designated representative to sign any and all amendments that do not increase the cost the authorized Agreement amount.

DOT staff have prepared a draft Resolution which provides for said authorization for the Board's consideration and adoption.
