

ORDINANCE NO. 4544

ORDINANCE OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING TITLE 2 – COUNTY CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

This ordinance updates and revises Chapter 2.28 of Title 2 of the Mendocino County Code, which pertains to the duties and responsibilities of the County Chief Executive Officer. Proposed amendments include updating Chapter 2.28 to define the annual evaluation process, and clarifying duties in providing support to the Board of Supervisors, particularly concerning the preparation of Board agenda requests and reports on the status of budget expenditures and revenues.
