Statement of Purpose

There is an obvious and significant need to ensure that Mendocino County is planning ahead for the necessary improvement and replacement of current library facilities.

Goals:

1. Develop a capital improvement fund dedicated to the long term capital improvement of all the library facilities in Mendocino County.
2. Develop a long term plan for the improvement and or replacement of the Ukiah Library
3. Develop long range plans for all branches and future branches.

Strategies to Achieve Goals:

1. In 2022 , voters will be asked to approve a permanent renewal of Measure A with an increase of 1/8 of 1% ((one eighth of one percent) for a total of 1/4 of 1% (one fourth of one percent.) The additional 1/8 of 1% would be dedicated to a capital improvement fund. A campaign for approval of the measure will be time-lined well in advance.
2. In Spring of 2018 a committee will be established, the Ukiah Library Improvement Working Group. The purpose of the committee will be to plan for the future of the Ukiah Library facilities.

Members: In order to promote collaboration and communication the Ukiah Library Improvement Working Group will be composed of representatives from each of the following agencies:

- Library Advisory Board
- Ukiah Friends of the Library
- Ukiah City Council
- Mendocino County Board of Supervisors

Auspices: The Ukiah Library Improvement Working Group may be convened under direction of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, or if not, by the Mendocino County Library Advisory Board.
