Under the terms of Resolution No. 15-132, the Historical Society of Mendocino County, the beneficiary of the Toney Trust, requests that the following funds be transferred from the Trust to reimburse the Society for capital improvements as listed below. Fire hardening, gutters, and gutter guards for the Held Home and the Toney Archive	\$ 5,310.82
Total request:	\$61,920.32
