NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Mendocino will conduct a public meeting on December 17, 2024, to discuss a possible application for funding under the USDA Rural Development Community Facilities Grant Program and potential activities to be included in the application. The meeting will be held during the regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting on December 17th between 9 am and 5 pm in Board Chambers at 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah, California.

The USDA Rural Development Community Facilities Grant Program provides funding for essential community facilities in rural areas. It can be used for purchasing, constructing, and improving facilities, acquiring equipment, and covering related project expenses.

The Mendocino County Sheriff's Office is applying for the USDA Rural Development Community Facilities Grant to secure funding for two fully equipped patrol vehicles. These vehicles will improve emergency response and enhance law enforcement services.

Residents and interested parties are encouraged to attend the hearing and provide input on the proposed grant application. Written comments may also be submitted prior to the hearing online via eComment on the County's website.
