


**ANDERSON VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
ELECTION CONSOLIDATION**

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-02



A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ELECTION DAY OF THE ANDERSON VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVIORS FOR THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO TO AUTHORIZE CONSOLIATION WITH THE NOVEMBER ELECTION DURING EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS

WHEREAS, the Anderson Valley Community Services District is legally organized under California Government Code (61000 et. seq.) for the purpose of providing public fire protection, ambulance, street lighting, airport and recreation services within the boundaries of the District; and,

WHEREAS, the Anderson Valley Community Services District must ensure that all aspects of the fire protection, ambulance, street lighting, airport, and recreation services provide the maximum public benefit conditioned upon fiscally responsible standards; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature has enacted SB 415 (Elections Code section 14050 et. seq.) which requires political subdivisions to change the election day for its Governing Board to the same day as a statewide general election when voter turnout for that local election is at least 25% less than voter turnout compared to the previous four statewide general elections; and

WHEREAS, studies have shown that voter participation in local elections dramatically improves when local elections are held on the same day as statewide elections; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Governing Board of the Anderson Valley Community Services District to encourage maximum voter turnout and community participation in the democratic electoral process and to comply with the mandate of SB 415; and

WHEREAS, sections 1303(b) and 10404 of the Elections Code permits the Anderson Valley Community Services District to change its election day for its Governing Board with the approval of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DECLARED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.** That pursuant to Elections Code Sections 1303(b) and 10404, the Board of Directors hereby, by this resolution, changes its election day from the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each odd-numbered year to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year, commencing in 2020, so that the election scheduled for 2017 will go forward as scheduled, but each subsequent election will be held on even-numbered years; and, further, that the election shall be consolidated with all other elections held throughout the territory on that day.
- Section 2.** That terms of the officeholders shall be extended as necessary, but shall not be extended beyond 12 months.
- Section 3.** That the Registrar of Voters shall cause, at District expense, a notice to be mailed to all registered voters in the Anderson Valley Community Services District informing them of the change of election date specified herein and of the resultant changes in terms of the elected officeholders.
- Section 4.** That this resolution shall become operative upon approval by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino pursuant to Elections Code sections 1303 (b) and 10404.
- Section 5.** That the District CLERK is hereby directed to transmit a copy of the Resolution 2017-02 to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Mendocino County.
