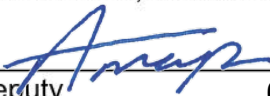

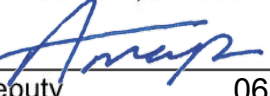

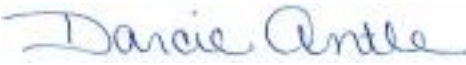

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FAR 52.217-8 Option to Extend Services. (Nov 1999)

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. These rates may be adjusted only as a result of revisions to prevailing labor rates provided by the Secretary of Labor.

The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 30 days of the expiration of the contract.

FAR 52.217-9 Option to Extend the Term of the Contract. (Nov 1999)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 60 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 30 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 60 months.

(b) In connection with the performance of work under this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

(3) In the event of the Contractor's or a subcontractor's noncompliance with this clause, this contract may be canceled, terminated, or suspended in whole or in part, and the Contractor or subcontractor may be declared ineligible for further Government contracts;

(4) The Contractor will report any subcontractor's known or reasonably knowable conduct that may violate this clause to the Contracting Officer and take any appropriate remedial actions directed by the Contracting Officer; and

(5) The Contractor will inform the Contracting Officer if a subcontractor sues the Contractor and the suit puts at issue, in any way, the validity of this clause.

(6) The Contractor recognizes that compliance with the requirements of this clause are material to the Government's payment decisions for purposes of 31 U.S.C. 3729(b)(4).

(c) The Contractor must include the substance of this clause, including this paragraph (c), in subcontracts at any tier, including those for commercial products and commercial services, except those where the place of delivery or performance is outside the United States.

(2) Energy- and water-efficient products that are ENERGY STAR® certified or Federal Energy Management Program (FEMP)-designated products ([42 U.S.C. 8259b](#)) ([10 CFR part 436, subpart C](#)) (<https://www.energy.gov/eere/femp/search-energy-efficient-products> and <https://www.energystar.gov/products?s=mega>).

(3) Biobased products meeting the content requirement of the USDA under the BioPreferred® program ([7 U.S.C. 8102](#)) ([7 CFR part 3201](#)) (<https://www.biopreferred.gov>).

(4) Acceptable chemicals, products, and manufacturing processes listed under EPA's Significant New Alternatives Policy (SNAP) program, which ensures a safe and smooth transition away from substances that contribute to the depletion of stratospheric ozone ([42 U.S.C. 7671l](#)) ([40 CFR part 82, subpart G](#)) (<https://www.epa.gov/snap>).

(b) *Requirements.*

(1) The sustainable products and services, including the purchasing program and type of product or service, that are applicable to this contract, and any products or services that are not subject to this clause, will be set forth in the statement of work or elsewhere in the contract.

(2) The Contractor shall ensure that the sustainable products and services required by this contract are—

(i) Delivered to the Government;

(ii) Furnished for use by the Government;

(iii) Incorporated into the construction of a public building or public work; and

(iv) Furnished for use in performing services under this contract, where the cost of the products is a direct cost to this contract (versus costs which are normally applied to the Contractor's general and administrative expenses or indirect costs). This includes services performed by contractors performing management and operation of Government-owned facilities to the same extent that, at the time of award, an agency would be required to comply if an agency operated or supported the facility.

Performance Work Statement (PWS)

PWS 1.0 Background on the Government's Requirement

The purpose of this contract is to provide law enforcement radio dispatch services for the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) law enforcement officers from the Ukiah Field Office and detailed law enforcement officers, as needed. This service is an essential service for the proficient response and safety of BLM's law enforcement officers working on BLM managed lands within Mendocino County. Currently, the BLM Ukiah Field Office law enforcement officers do not have law enforcement radio dispatch opportunities in Mendocino County.

This contract will renew the original contract established with Mendocino County Sheriff's Office Communication Center (PO #: L10PX03791). That contract's performance period was for one year (January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2011) and included 4 additional option years, with the final option year ending on December 31, 2014. The contract was renewed with the Mendocino County Sheriff's Communication Center (PO #: L16PX00630), with a performance period which ran from May 1, 2016, through April 30, 2017, and included 4 additional option years, with the final option year ending on April 30, 2021. The contract was again renewed (PO: 140L1221P0027), with a performance period which ran from May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022 and included 4 additional option years, with the final option year ending on April 30, 2026.

PWS 2.0 General Scope of Work

The Contractor shall provide Bureau of Land Management's law enforcement officers with law enforcement dispatch services on an as needed basis.

Services shall include providing Bureau of Land Management's law enforcement officers with needed law enforcement information such as drivers' licenses, registration, warrants, criminal history, and officer safety information not currently available. The Communication Center will also perform status checks during law enforcement contacts and send back-up sheriff's deputies when needed.

Place of Performance:

This contract would provide law enforcement radio dispatch services for Bureau of Land Management law enforcement officers within Mendocino County, California.

Period of Performance:

The period of performance shall be for one (1) Base Year of 12 months and four (4) 12-month option years. The Period of Performance reads as follows:

Performance Work Statement (PWS)

PWS 3.0 Overall Objective(s)

The objective of this work is provide the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) law enforcement officers with radio dispatch services within Mendocino County.

PWS 4.0 Extent of Services

The Contractor shall provide law enforcement radio dispatch services to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) law enforcement officers subject to the following terms and conditions:

- Radio traffic to and from on-duty BLM law enforcement officers will be on mobile and portable radios. This will be conducted on the COUNTY primary use channel frequencies. The COUNTY will remain the licensee for these frequencies. The COUNTY grants BLM the right to use these frequencies for the purpose of fulfilling this contract. While utilizing these frequencies, the BLM agrees to comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission. The responsibility for renewal, maintenance, changes and upgrades to the frequency's licenses shall vest solely with the COUNTY.
- Radio communications between the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office Communications Center and the BLM shall be via the COUNTY communications system.
- Emergency and non-emergency calls for service shall be dispatched according to the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office CAD protocols; pre-arrival instructions and unit recommendations.
- Radio transmissions by BLM personnel to Mendocino County Sheriff's Office Communications Center shall conform to the standards and practices used by the Mendocino County Communications Center Dispatch Protocol. This includes, but is not limited to, the format for notifying dispatch of officer-initiated activity, the format for requesting automated systems inquiries and the format for call dispositions.
- E911 calls for fire and ambulance within Mendocino County are handled by the Mendocino County Sheriff's Office Communications Center.
- When Mendocino County Sheriff's Office and Bureau of Land Management calls are handled jointly by one or more dispatchers, the priority assigned to any call will be determined solely by the nature of the call.
- BLM is responsible for answering Bureau of Land Management business calls.

PWS 5.0 Government-Furnished Property, Materials, Services

General:

The Contractor shall furnish all personnel, materials, equipment, supplies, facilities, transportation, tools, materials, supervision, and other items and non-personal services

necessary to provide the services specified in this contract, with the exception of any BLM equipment and vehicles.

PWS 6.0 Technical Exhibits and Definitions

Standard Definitions:

Physical Condition

The Physical appearance of Federal equipment or facilities that considers cracks, chips, dents, abrasions, rust, corrosion, general cleanliness, vibration, operating temperature, and discoloration and other items as identified by the COR..

Physical condition may be determined by visual as well as diagnostic means.

Contracting Officer (CO)

The Secretary of the Interior or designated authorized representative who is the only agent capable of signing a federal award or obligating funds.

Contracting Officer's Representative (COR)

The Contracting Officer's designated representative as indicated in a delegation of authority letter.

Quality Assurance (QA)

Surveillance of Contractor performance to determine performance requirements are met.

Performance Requirements Summary (PRS) (see Technical Exhibit below)

The PRS identifies the key performance indicators of the Contract that will be evaluated by the Government to assure Contract performance standards are met by the Contractor.

Quality Control

Those actions taken by the Contractor to control the production of goods or services so that they meet the requirements of the performance work statement.

Technical Definitions:

Dispatch Services

Services routinely provided by a primary public safety answering point, including, but not limited to:

- Receipt, recording, dispatching and forwarding of non-emergency calls for service
- Two way radio communication with mobile and portable radios
- Audio recording of radio transmissions conducted on primary use channels

E911

Enhanced 9-1-1 emergency number system, which will provide an automatic display of the caller's telephone number, subscriber's name and subscriber's location to the dispatcher.

Performance Work Statement (PWS)

Dispatcher

Public safety dispatcher, as defined by California Code of Regulations, Title 11, Div. 2, Art. 1, Sec. 1001, subsection (w). "Dispatcher" shall also be synonymous with the COUNTY job classification of Communications Dispatcher.

CAD

Computer aided dispatch system: a combination of hardware and software, which allows for the input, tracking, recording and reporting of calls for service.

Computer Equipment

Computer hardware, software and peripherals.

Calls

Communication that conveys or requests information, assigns or directs action, or requests services. This includes communication between officers and dispatchers.

"MAY" is permissive.

"SHOULD" is desirable.

"SHALL" is mandatory.
