NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors at its regular meeting on Tuesday, June 21, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., to be held in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, County Administration Center, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah, California, will conduct a public hearing regarding the Allocation of the County's CDBG Program Income Funds at the time listed, or as soon thereafter as the item(s) may be heard.

A public meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on May 5, 2016 at the Department of Planning and Building Services, 860 N. Bush Street in Ukiah to discuss eligible uses of CDBG funding, community needs, and to receive public input.

Copies of the recommended allocations of CDBG funds and other details of the Board of Supervisors item will be available for public inspection on May 18, 2016 at the Department of Planning and Building Services, 860 Bush Street, Ukiah, California, during regular business hours.

Your comments regarding the recommended allocations are invited. Written comments should be submitted to the Department of Planning and Building Services, 860 N. Bush Street, Ukiah, California, 95482, no later than May 31, 2016. Oral comments may be presented to the Board of Supervisors during the public hearing. Following the public hearing, County Staff will submit the required documentation to the California Department of Housing and Community Development to allocate the CDBG funding according to Board of Supervisors direction.

If you plan on attending the Public Hearing and need a special accommodation because of a sensory or mobility impairment/disability, please contact the aforementioned County department to arrange for those accommodations to be made.
