RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH SERVICE EMPLOYEES' INTERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL 1021 (SEIU)

WHEREAS, the Meyers-Milius-Brown Act requires that units of local government meet and confer with employee representatives for the purpose of developing agreements regarding wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors have met and conferred regarding provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding with representatives from SEIU LOCAL 1021; and

WHEREAS, these representatives have agreed upon contractual language for the parties' Memorandum of Understanding concerning wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment effective July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2029, and attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding terms will not have a negative impact on the funding status of the Mendocino County Employees' Retirement Association as required by Government Code Section 23026; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding hereby amends and fully supersedes the parties' previously approved memorandum of understanding, effective July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds the Memorandum of Understanding to be proper and suitable and hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors formally approves the attached Memorandum of Understanding, signed by representatives of the Board of Supervisors and by representatives of SEIU LOCAL 1021.
