Re: BoS Response to "Measure B Re-Examined," June 2022

Dear Supervisor McGourty:

The Grand Jury received the response of Supervisor Ted Williams on behalf of the Board of Supervisors to the above-titled report and finds that it does not fully comply with the requirements of California Penal Code section 933.05, in the following respects:

- Response to Recommendation 2: Pursuant to Penal Code section 933.05(b)(3), a response that a recommendation "requires further analysis" must provide an explanation addressing the scope and parameters of analysis or study with a timeframe for the matter to be discussed, not to exceed six months from the publication of the report.

An excerpt from Penal Code Section 933.05 is enclosed for your reference.

The Grand Jury requests that you resubmit the response in its entirety within ten days of the date of this letter, following the directions contained in the original letter of transmittal.

Cal Penal Code § 933.05 Responses to grand jury reports (excerpt):

(b) For purposes of subdivision (b) of Section 933, as to each grand jury recommendation, the responding person or entity shall report one of the following actions:

- (1) The recommendation has been implemented, with a summary regarding the implemented action.
- (2) The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but will be implemented in the future, with a timeframe for implementation.
- (3) The recommendation requires further analysis, with an explanation and the scope and parameters of an analysis or study, and a timeframe for the matter to be prepared for discussion by the officer or head of the agency or department being investigated or reviewed, including the governing body of the public agency when applicable. This timeframe shall not exceed six months from the date of publication of the grand jury report.
- (4) The recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable, with an explanation therefor.
