will face the winner of the contest between Middletown (who the Wolves beat two weeks ago) and St. Vincent de Paul.

Last Friday, Fort Bragg built an early lead and Wolves defenders again kept the lid on the opponents' offense on the way to a convincing win.

After shutting out the Wolverines in the first half for a 24-0 lead, the Wolves prevented a comeback with three interceptions, one each by Jullian Clavelle, William Robertson and Justin Mertle.

Early running touchdowns by Robertson and Clavelle set up a 12-0 lead midway through the second quarter, when a Fort Bragg drive ended with Logan Ponts scoring from the four. As the half wound down, Clavelle took to the

air, completing a 54-yard romp to Ash Price to get Fort Bragg into scoring position, followed by a 30-plus yard scoring strike to Mertle.

Robertson had a breakout performance, running for 202 yards and a pair of touchdowns — and breaking the 1000-yard mark for the year — as the Wolves

leaned heavily on him and their offensive line to carve out a commanding lead.

Fort Bragg's running game branched out against Willits, with ten ball carriers, including some of the o-line, combining for 317 yards and four touchdowns. Logan Ponts (34 yards and a touchdown), Wyatt Curti (25 yards), Jullian Clavelle (23 yards and a touchdown), Cody Filosi (12 yards), Jeremy Segura (12 yards), James Nelson (five yards), Isaac Arnold (two yards), Andrew Johnston (1 yard) Johnny Delgado (1 yard) all contributed to the effort.

Clavelle threw for 101 yards and a touchdown, spreading the ball among receivers Ash Price (54 yards), Justin Mertle (42 yards and a touchdown) and Robertson (five yards.)

Cody Filosi led Timberwolf tacklers with ten stops. Ponts had five tackles, Segura and Delgado had four and Clavelle, Robertson and Mertle had three each.

REQUEST: Mendocino County proposes to (1) Amend the Mendocino County Code-Chapter 10A.17-Cannabis Cultivation, (2) Amend Chapter 20.242-Cannabis Cultivation Site, of the Inland Zoning Ordinance (Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division I), (3) Add Chapter 20.118 Cannabis Accommodation Combining District and Chapter 20.119 Commercial Cannabis Prohibition Combining District to the Inland Zoning Ordinance (Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division I), and (4) Rezone certain properties to apply the Cannabis Accommodation Combining District in areas within the Covelo Core and Covelo-Fairbanks Road, Laytonville, South Leggett, and the Mitchell Creek areas near Fort Bragg; and apply the Cannabis Prohibition Combining District to the Deerwood and Boonville Road-Woodyglen areas of Ukiah Valley.

SUMMARY: Amendments to County Code Chapters 10A.17 Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance and 20.242 Cannabis Cultivation Sites would provide greater flexibility for setbacks and lot sizes in the review of cannabis cultivation permits. The new Chapter 20.118 Cannabis Accommodation (CA) Combining District is intended to support continued operation of existing cultivation sites and the new Chapter 20.119 Cannabis Prohibition (CP) Combining District is intended to prohibit new commercial cannabis uses and would sunset existing permitted commercial cannabis uses. Also proposed is the establishment of the first CA and CP Districts.

LOCATION: Unincorporated inland areas within Mendocino County in addition, specific areas as noted. Mitchell Creek Area, Fort Bragg; Covelo Core, Covelo Fairbanks Road, Covelo; Laytonville; South Leggett; Deerwood and Boonville Road-Woodyglen areas of Ukiah Valley. The areas not included are, the city limits of Ukiah, Fort Bragg, Willits and Point Arena. Not applicable to those areas within the designated Coastal Zone Areas of the County.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Addendum to adopted Mitigated Negative Declaration

PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION: The Planning Commission, at their October 18, 2018 meeting, adopted a resolution recommending that the Board of Supervisors approve Ordinance Amendment No. OA\_2018-0008, which will make amendments to Chapters 10A.17 and 20.242 and add Chapters 20.118 and 20.119 to the Mendocino County Code, with modifications as specified in the resolution. The resolution further recommends that the Board of Supervisors (1) approve the rezoning of the Covelo Core, Covelo-Fairbanks Road, Laytonville and South Leggett areas to the CA Combining District, and (2) approve the rezoning of the Deerwood and Boonville Road-Woodyglen areas to the CP Combining District. The Planning Commission specifically recommended that the Board of Supervisors not rezone the Mitchell Creek areas near Fort Bragg to the CA Combining District.
