

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED
ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 15.16 - PROTECTION OF COUNTY ROADS, ADDING SECTION 15.16.070 - PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO COUNTY ROAD AND SECTION 15.16.080 - ENFORCEMENT OF SECTION 15.16.070 (COUNTY-WIDE)

This Ordinance adds Section 15.16.070 - Prohibited Activities within or adjacent to County Road, to the Mendocino County Code, prohibiting any improvement or condition within or adjacent to a County road right-of-way which undermines the safe operation or integrity of the County roadway or which interferes with County road drainage. This Ordinance also adds Section 15.16.080 - Enforcement of Section 15.16.070, to the Mendocino County Code, which authorizes enforcement actions for constructing such improvements or causing or maintaining such a condition, including the imposition of administrative penalties.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on September 10, 2019.
