This seems like a much riskier proposition than allowing one customer at a time at a central location such as a salon.

A salon is a much more controlled environment and by its nature more sanitary than individual residences.

I do not see how allowing one person to move from residence to residence to residence follows the spirit of the Public Health Order. It does, however, seem like a more effective way to spread any illness.
