

SUMMARY

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.48.010 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF PLANNING COMMISSIONERS

This ordinance amends section 2.48.010 of the Mendocino County Code regarding the establishment and appointment of Planning Commissioners. Currently, the Board of Supervisors appoints seven (7) total members to the Planning Commission: one member from each supervisorial district, one at-large member with a demonstrated knowledge of agriculture and one at-large member with a demonstrated knowledge of forestry. This ordinance would make the Planning Commission a body of five (5) members, one from each supervisorial district, eliminating the two at-large members with knowledge of agriculture and forestry. In addition, the section provides for the appointment of alternate members for each of the five (5) seats, one from each supervisorial district. Alternate members may only act in the absence of the regular member serving from the same supervisorial district.
