



**Summary of COVID-19 FEMA Grant as of May 31, 2021**

For the period January 1-May 31, 2021, the Community Foundation of Mendocino County distributed \$184,749.69 of \$196,000 available in COVID-19 FEMA grant funds to nine (9) organizations, which over five months have served over 64,830 meals to seniors and individuals with underlying health conditions throughout Mendocino County. There is \$11,250.31 remaining to grant out in June for contract #20-038.

\$184,749.69 has been distributed in monthly reimbursement grants to the following organizations. For a detailed breakdown of organizational impact by month including numbers served, see the subsequent pages.

The addition of \$250,000 in regranting funds for June 1-December will provide a similar level of prepared meals for seniors on a monthly basis for the remainder of the year. Our community partners report no significant change in demand thus far this year although most hope to resume in person dining to help seniors feel less isolated now that the majority are vaccinated. The nine organizations deeply appreciate the funding (approximately \$37,000/month) the County of Mendocino/FEMA has provided them to meet the increased need resulting from the pandemic and will gladly serve those who have participated in the Great Plates Program should they need an alternative source of prepared meals in July-December, 2021.
