RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY (HHSA) TO ACCEPT FUTURE SOBER TRUTH ON PREVENTING UNDERAGE DRINKING ACT (STOP ACT) GRANTS AWARDED TO HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY, PUBLIC HEALTH, PREVENTION AND PLANNING UNIT (PAPU)

WHEREAS, the HHSA will notify the County Executive Office, County Counsel and Risk Management for review of all renewals, documents and/or subsequent amendments associated with the STOP Act grant as per County Policy 25; and

WHEREAS, the STOP Act grant will benefit the County and its residents by reducing underage alcohol use by funding alcohol abuse prevention and community engagement in environmental social change advocacy through the Coalition for Gang Awareness and Prevention (CGAP) in the Fort Bragg community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Mendocino County Health and Human Services Agency Director or designee to accept and sign for all future STOP Act grant renewal applications and authorizes the HHSA Director to sign any future amendments to the grant that do not affect the annual maximum amount.
