



Mendocino County Animal Care Services

- So far this year we have had an intake of 1298 animals
- 90% combined live release rate to date this year
- 318 Return to owner
- Currently 73 dogs and 124 cats in shelter





Care-A-Van Services



- From January 2016 through June 2016, the Care-A-Van has spayed/neutered 235 cats and 207 dogs
- “SNAP Only” vouchers
- Care-A-Van has provided services to Willits, Covelo, Laytonville, Fort Bragg and Manchester
- The goal is to have the Care-A-Van in communities at least 2 days a week
- Shelter staff are being trained to assist on the CAV



Volunteer update



Through July 2016

There have been 2 volunteer meetings and a volunteer handbook has been developed.

There are foster orientations monthly and a foster handbook is being developed and will be available by September.



The Shelter continues to work with a large number of rescues

Rescues

- Work with non-profit 102 rescues
- 90 in California
- 12 out of state, one in Canada

So far in 2016, 350 animals have been transferred to other rescues
