AMENDMENT TO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AGREEMENT NO. 16-045

This Amendment to BOS Agreement No. 16-045 is entered into this 4th day of October, 2016, by and between the COUNTY OF MENDOCINO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and LACO Associates, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR".

WHEREAS, BOS Agreement No. 16-045 was entered into on June 21, 2016; and

WHEREAS, upon execution of this document by the Chair of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors and <u>LACO Associates</u>, this document will become part of the aforementioned contract and shall be incorporated therein; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of CONTRACTOR and COUNTY to increase the contract amount set out in the original BOS Agreement No. 16-045, from Not to exceed three hundred and seventy-six thousand eight hundred and twenty-six (\$376,826) to Not to exceed five hundred and seventy-four thousand eight hundred and one (\$574,801) for the term of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Water Agency (the "Agency") submitted a financial assistance application to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) on March 18, 2016, in order to receive assistance for the planning, design and development of the Coastal Mendocino County Stormwater Resource Plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Coastal Mendocino County Stormwater Resource Plan is to develop a regional stormwater resource plan for the municipal separate stormwater sewer system (NPDES) permittees for Mendocino County and the City of Fort Bragg; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2016, the SWRCB notified the Agency that its application was approved for funding with a grant award of \$242,990; and

WHEREAS, LACO Associates provides the County with professional services specific to Stromwater and NPDES under the current three year BOS Agreement No. 16-045; and

WHEREAS, increasing the contract amount to expand the NPDES scope of services enables the Agency to integrate our current NPDES contracted services with the development of a stormwater management plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, we agree as follows:

- 1. The contract amount set out in the original BOS Agreement No. <u>16-045</u> will be increased from <u>Not to exceed three hundred and seventy-six thousand eight hundred and twenty-six (\$376,826) to Not to exceed five hundred and seventy-four thousand eight hundred and one (\$574,801).</u>
- 2. Exhibit A, Definition of Services, is amended to include the services listed in the Exhibit A Addendum attached to this Amendment.
- 3. Exhibit B, Payment Terms, attached to the agreement is hereby replaced in its entirety by the Amended Exhibit B attached to this Amendment.

All other terms and conditions of BOS Agreement No. <u>16-045</u> shall remain in full force and effect.

DEFINITION OF SERVICES

PAYMENT TERMS

Contractor's billable hourly rate is as follows: Principal staff and Geologist Staff \$165-175, Planning staff \$110-118, Engineering Staff \$75-85, Environmental Scientist \$82, Administrative Support Staff \$65, Administrative Analyst \$75. Incidental expenses to be billed at cost. Travel expenses to be billed at the prevailing GAO rate (currently \$0.555 per mile).

Contractor will submit invoices no more than once every thirty (30) days, detailing the specific services provided and clearly explaining any incidental charges. Invoices will be reviewed by the department within seven (7) days.
