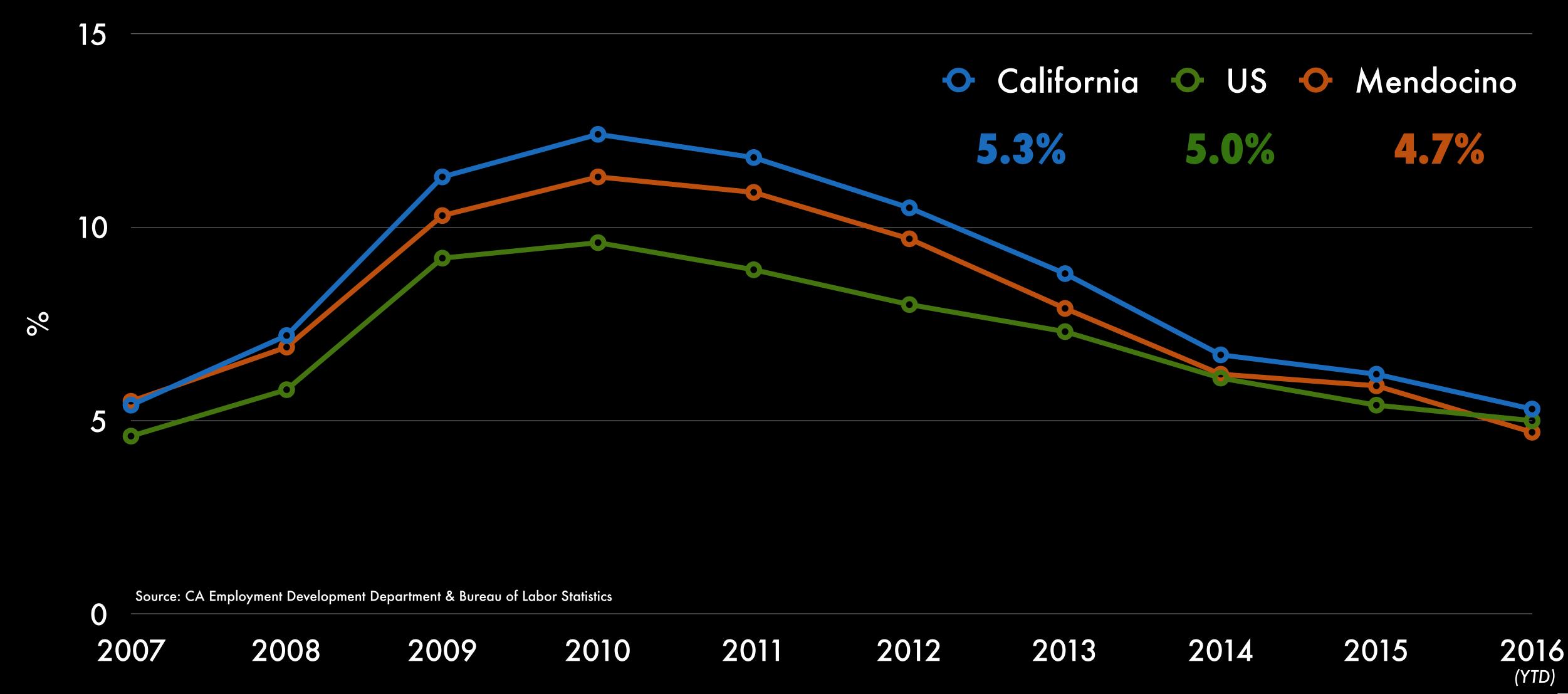

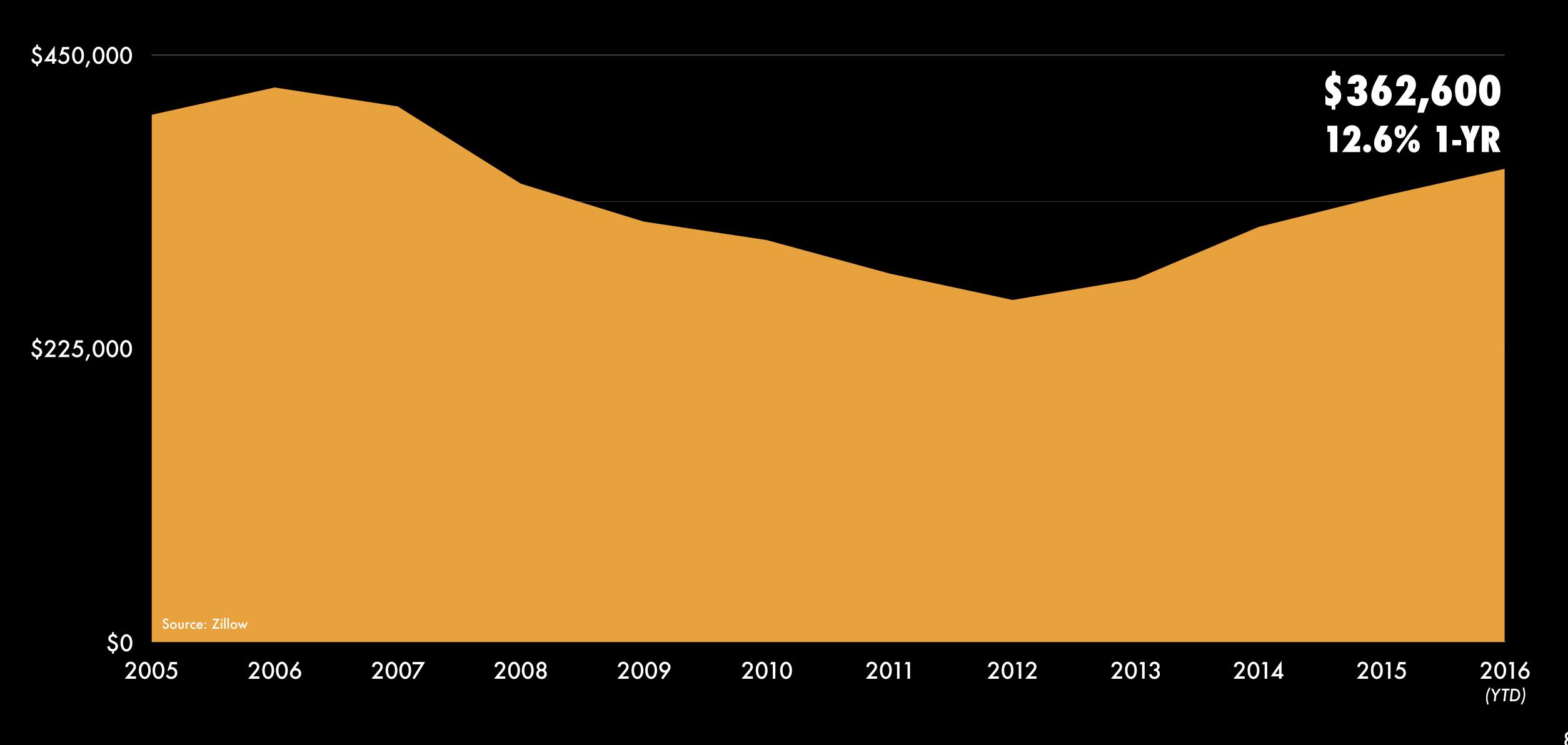

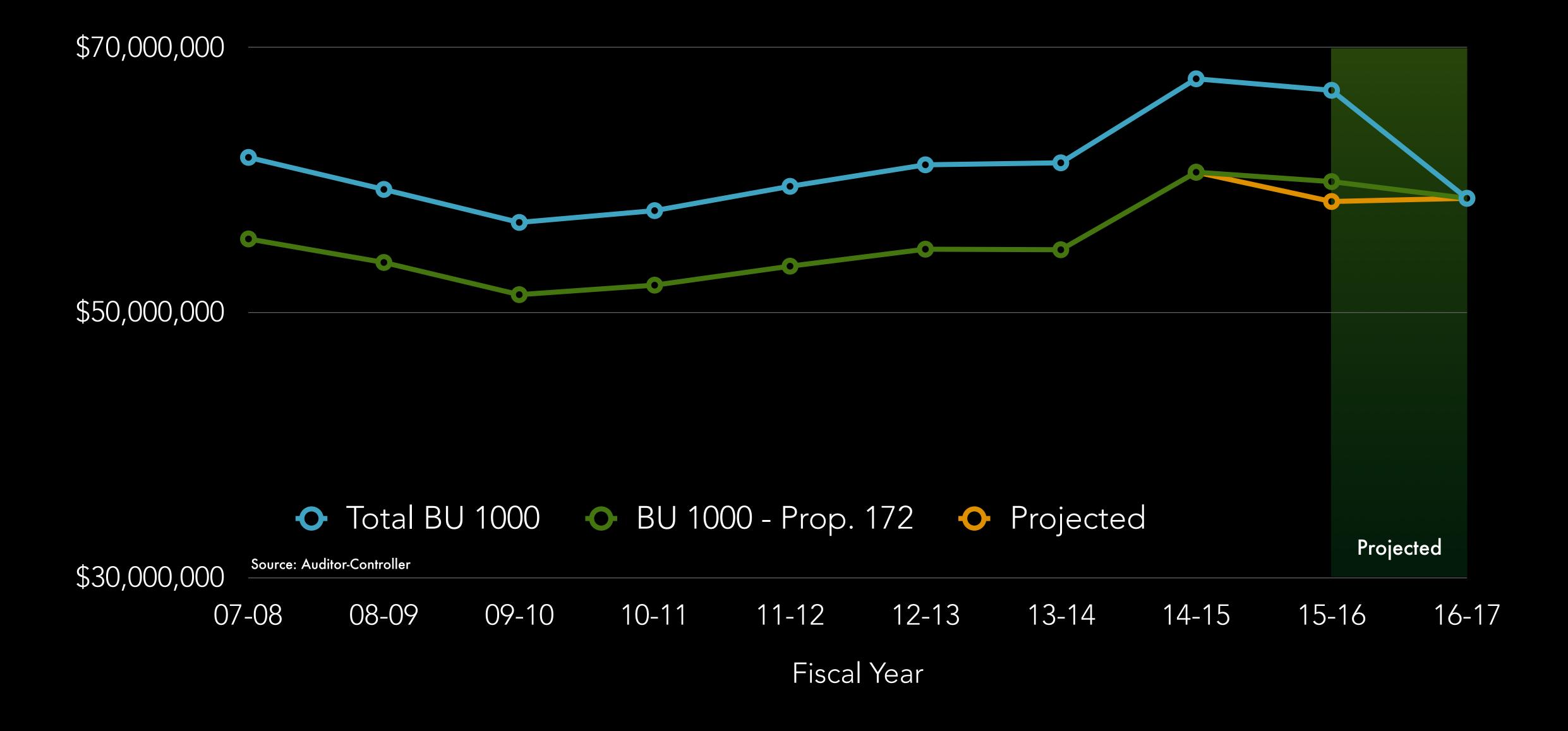
UNEMPLOYMENT RATE



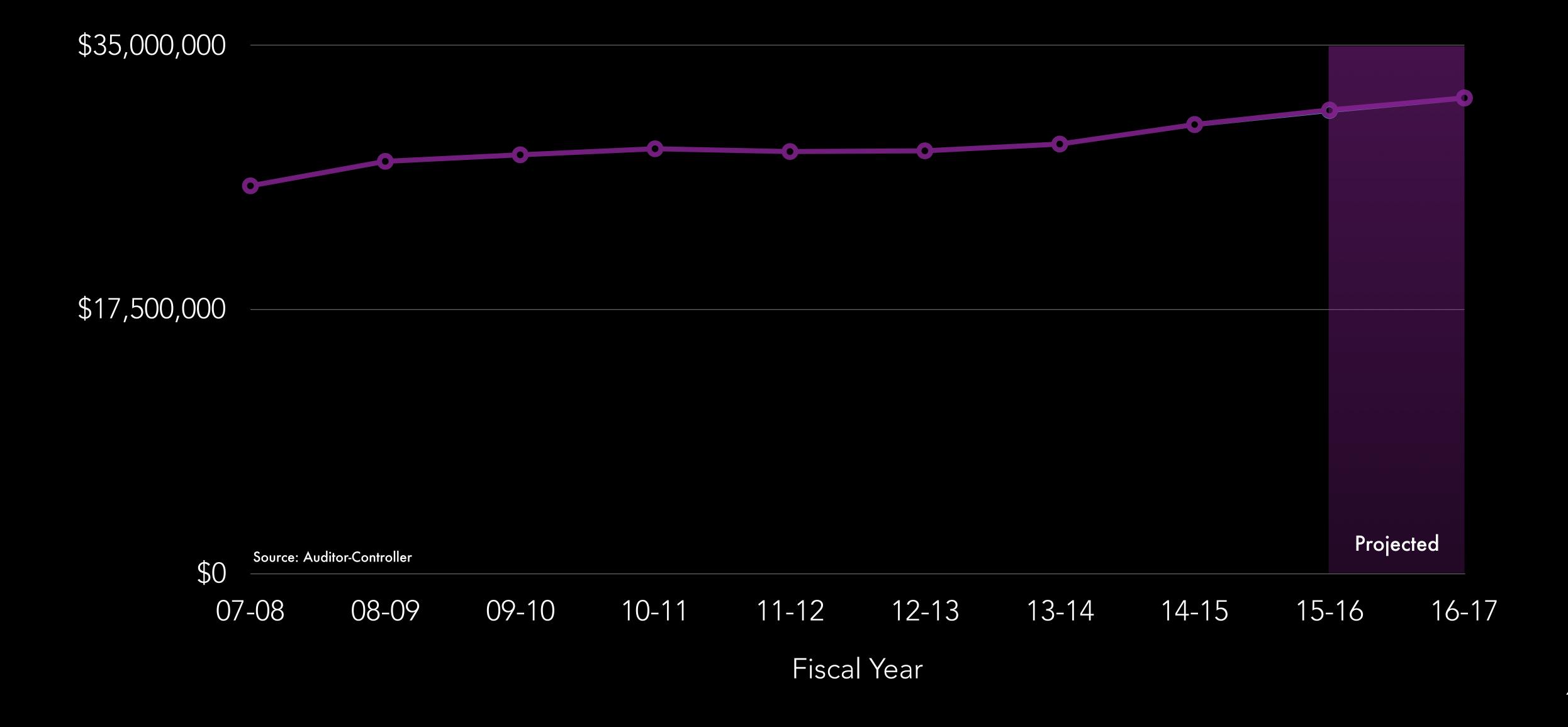
RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY VALUES



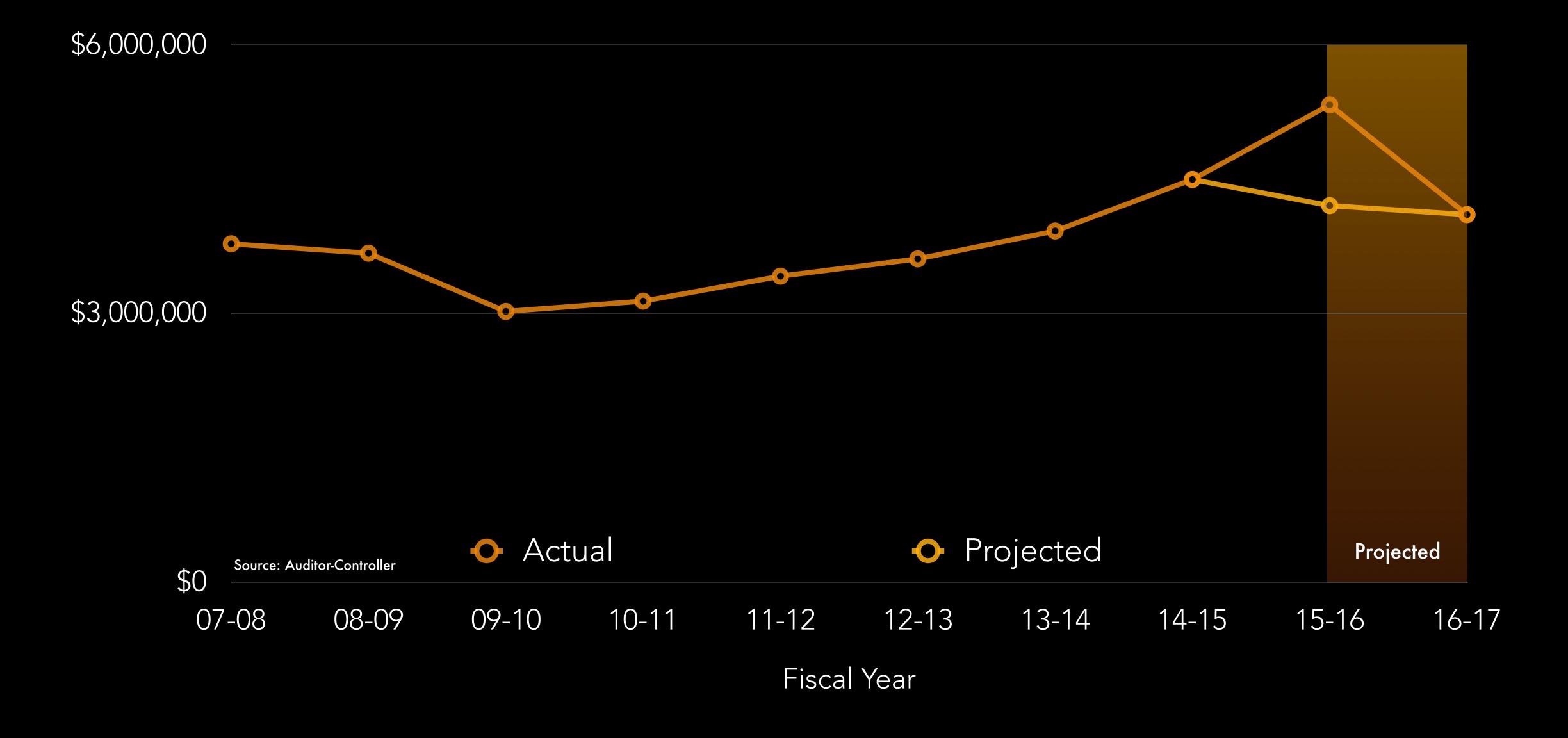
DISCRETIONARY REVENUE



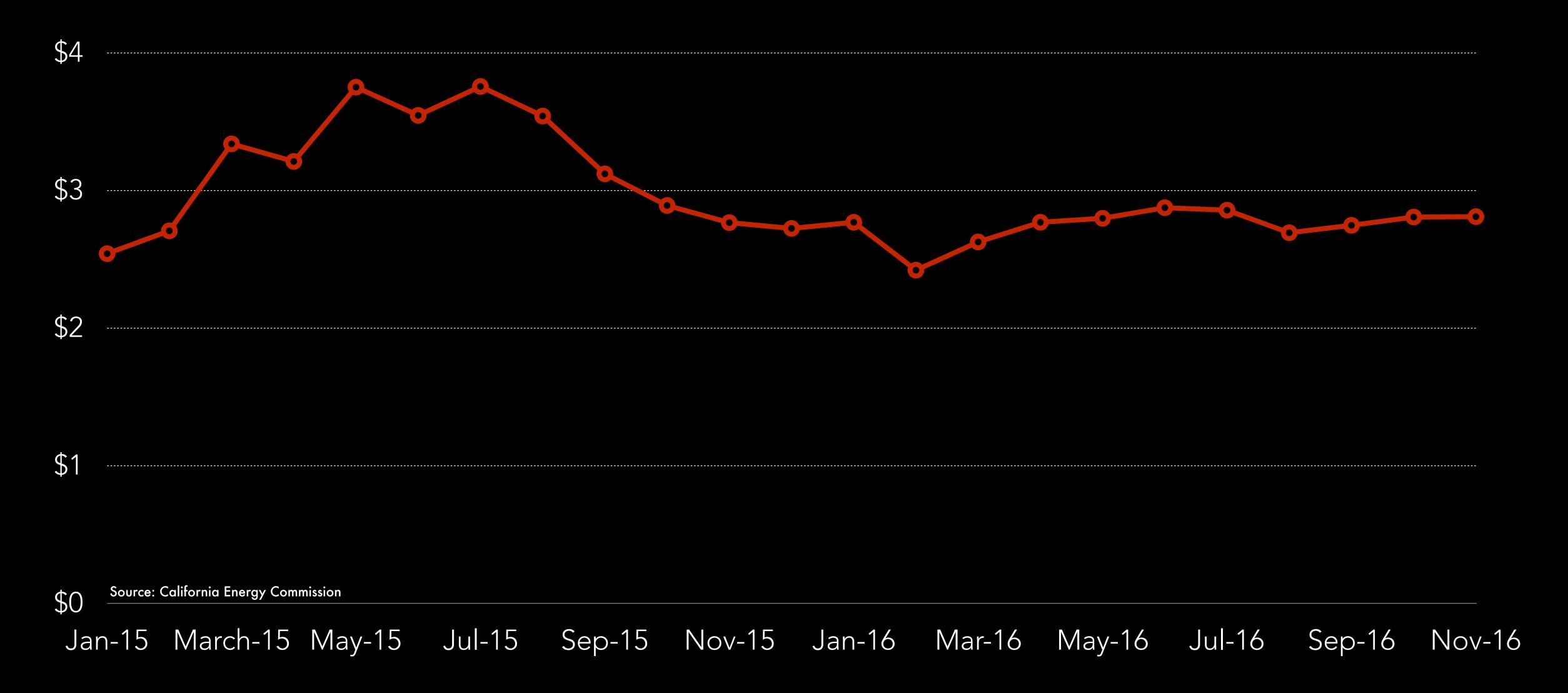
SECURED PROPERTY TAX REVENUE



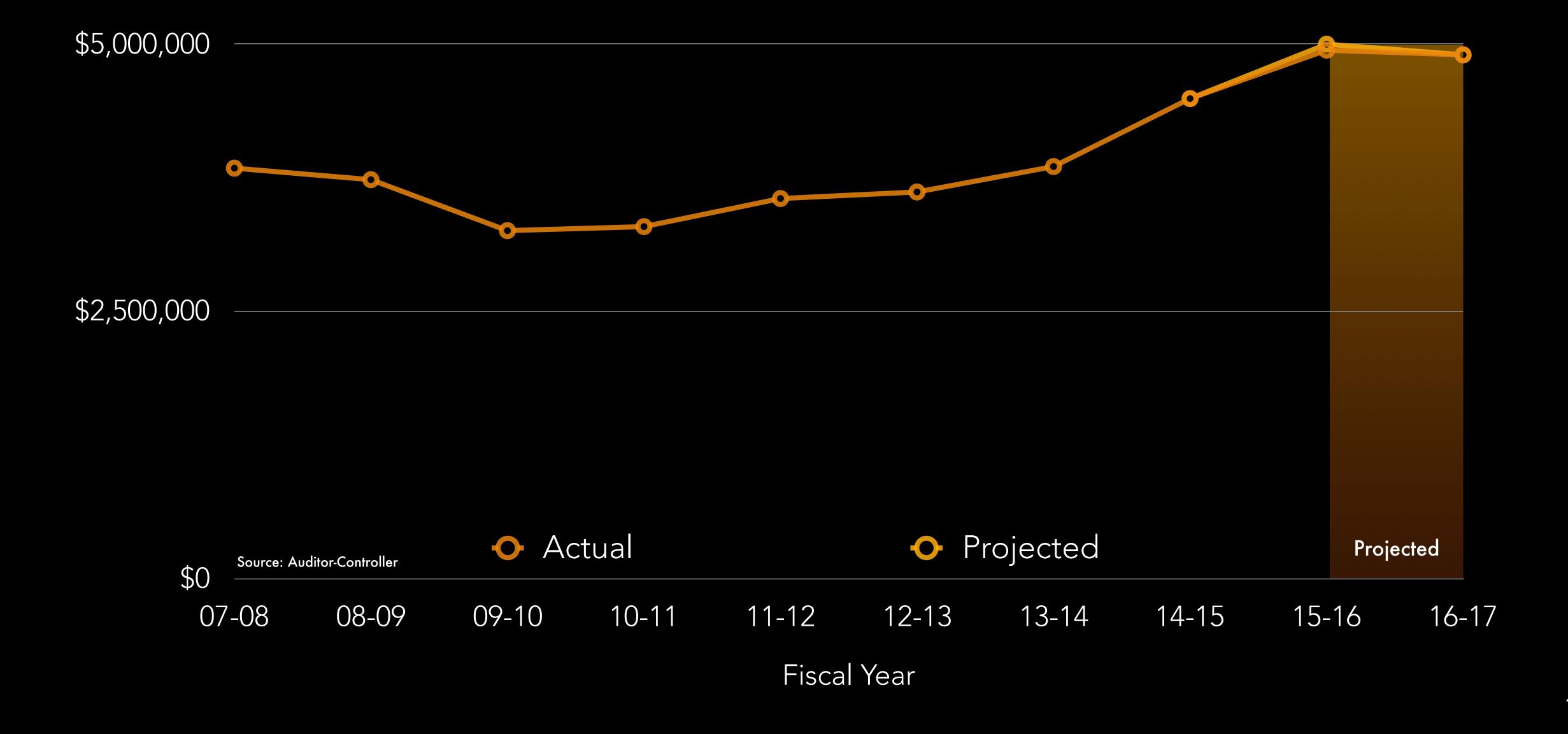
SALES TAX REVENUE - 1% COUNTY SHARE



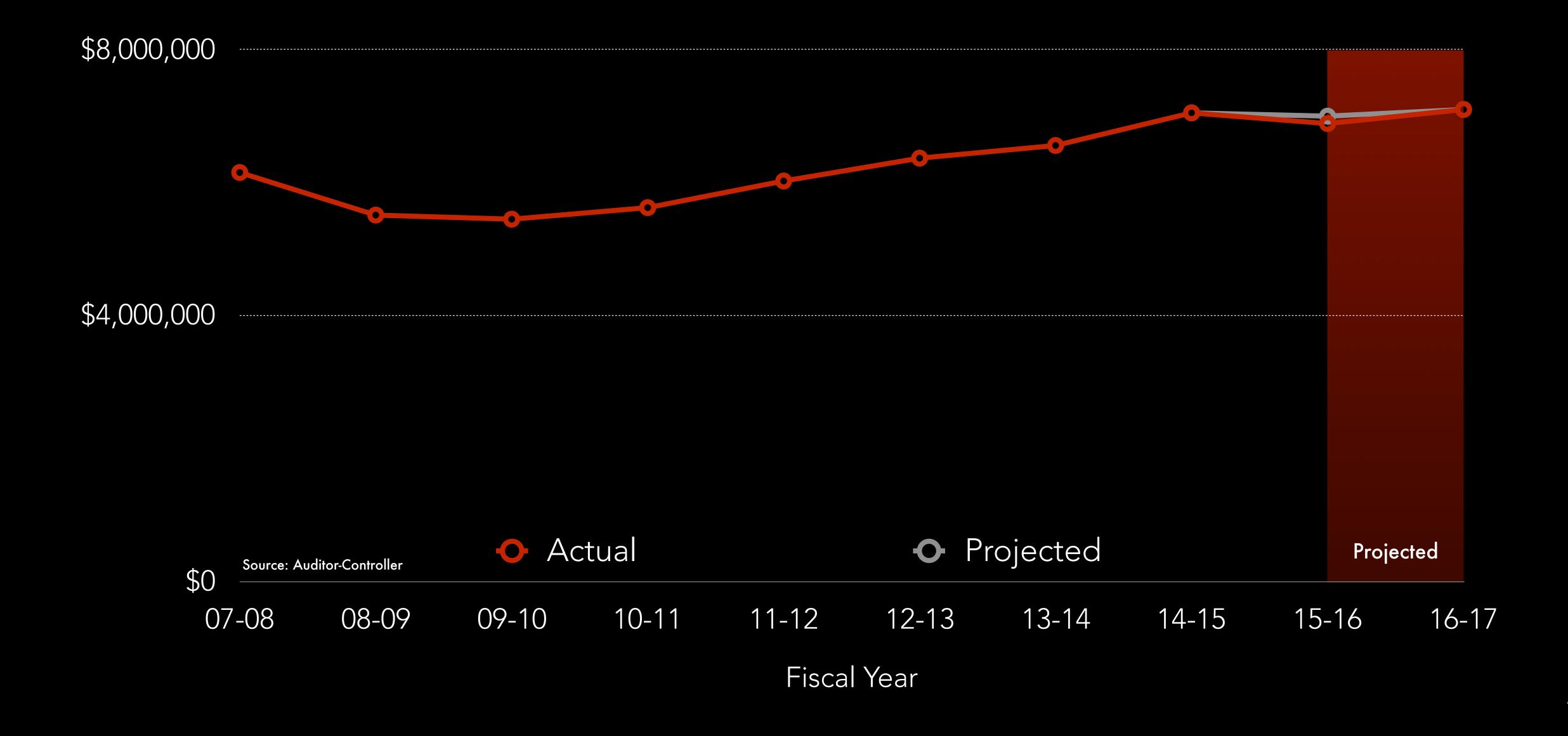
CA FUEL PRICES - MONTHLY AVG.

- Proposition 52 Medi-Cal Funding
 - Status quo local funding
- Proposition 57 Parole for "non-violent" felons
 - Increase in local impacts/costs
- Proposition 64 Recreational Cannabis
 - Various impacts



PENSION UPDATE

- UAAL
 - June 30, 2015: \$182.2 million
 - June 30, 2016: \$185.3 million (+\$3.1 million)
- Funded Ratio
 - June 30, 2015: 70.2%
 - June 30, 2016: 70.5%



PENSION UPDATE

- Employer Contribution Rate
 - June 30, 2015: 32.14% of payroll
 - June 30, 2016: 32.05% of payroll (-\$52,000)
- Employee Contribution Rate
 - June 30, 2015: 9.64% of payroll
 - June 30, 2016: 9.65% of payroll (+\$6,000)
