

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE CREATING CHAPTER 8.76 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE ESTABLISHING NUISANCE ABATEMENT PROCEDURES SPECIFIC TO CANNABIS CULTIVATION

This ordinance is creating Mendocino County Code Chapter 8.76 for the purpose of establishing nuisance abatement and code enforcement procedures applicable to nuisances caused by the cultivation of cannabis as an alternative to the abatement procedures in County Code Chapter 8.75. Provisions include: scope and chapter application; the required process prior to abatement by County, including issuance of the administrative order to show cause, automatic hearing procedures, and notice requirements; hearing procedures to be held by a hearing officer; procedures and timing for abatement by County; liability for costs of abatement, which will be on the responsible party; procedures for County to recover its costs; integration of the administrative citation and penalties procedures; integration of many sections from Chapter 8.75 where appropriate. The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on January 10, 2017.

A complete copy of the ordinance is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the Public Records Act.
