

#### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 3.16.140 OF CHAPTER 3.16 OF TITLE 3 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE ENTITLED "APPEALS"

This Ordinance currently requires appeal hearings to be conducted within twenty (20) days of the date the appeal is filed with the Civil Service Commission. In most cases, the appellant and the County are not able to prepare their respective cases and participate in the required pre-hearing conference/s within twenty (20) days. Modifying the requirement to conduct a hearing within thirty (30) business days provide a more practical opportunity for the parties to communicate, conduct the required pre-hearing conference/s and prepare their cases, and allow time staff to prepare the hearing items for the Commission and noticing of the hearing.

The ordinance amendment would take effect thirty (30) days following final adoption by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on January 10, 2017.

A complete copy of the ordinance is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the Public Records Act.
