

ORDINANCE NO. 4377

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.04 OF TITLE 3 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino Ordains as follows:

CHAPTER 3.04 Title 3 of the Mendocino County Code is amended to read as follows:

Chapter 3.04 – Personnel and Salary

Section 3.04.150 – Vacation Leave with Pay

Section 3.04.150 (G) – Vacation Termination Pay

Any employee after thirteen (13) pay periods of part-time service of twenty (20) hours or more per week in a regular allocated position or after thirteen (13) bi-weekly pay periods of full-time regular service shall be paid upon termination an amount of money equal to his or her accrued vacation. When an employee's effective date of termination occurs after the completion of one (1) full week in a given pay period, he or she shall be deemed to have accrued vacation leave for that pay period. A terminating employee may not be re-employed by the County for compensation except in an extra-help capacity until the total number of working days of accrued vacation have elapsed. This Section shall not prevent a department head from filling a vacated position immediately following the effective date of the employee's separation from his or her department, provided funds are available.
