OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT RE: ADOPTION OF THE OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD DEPARTMENT TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 160089 FOR AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$193,000. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HEARST WILLITS ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT ON HEARST WILLITS ROAD, COUNTY ROAD 306, MILE POST 1.68, AND AUTHORIZE A TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WITH DETOUR AROUND THE PROJECT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TWO WEEKS (WILLITS AREA)

Honorable Board Members:

Department of Transportation (DOT) Contract Number (No.) 160089 will provide for the construction of the Hearst Willits Road Culvert Replacement on Hearst Willits Road, County Road 306 at Mile Post 1.68.

A general contractor will be required to complete this project at an estimated cost of \$193,000, not including contingency and construction engineering. The project is to be funded entirely through the County Road Fund.

A temporary road closure to through traffic on Hearst Willits Road at Mile Post 1.68 will be required. Traffic may be easily routed around the project area through use of a detour to Valley Road to East Side Road to Canyon Road and visa-versa.

I recommend and request that the Board authorize and direct the Director of Transportation to advertise for bids and to award DOT Contract No. 160089 to construct the Hearst Willits Road Culvert Replacement on Hearst Willits Road, County Road 306 at Mile Post 1.68, and authorize a temporary road closure with a detour around the project for a period not to exceed two weeks. DOT staff personnel have prepared a draft Resolution which provides said authorization for the Board's consideration and adoption.
