SICPATRACE[®] IN CALIFORNIA

- Started in early 2005, recently extended through 2019
- System combines material and information security elements to allow the BOE to identify individual units within the supply chain
- Program covers the annual application of tax stamps on more than 900 million cigarette packs and is responsible for securing over \$800 million in excise tax revenues
- **\$90 million per year** in additional revenue collection, more than \$450 million since project inception




SICPA CANNABIS TRACK AND TRACE

- **City of Eureka** Expansion of Humboldt Program (in progress)





Establish a track and trace program for reporting the movement of <i>cannabis</i> items throughout the distribution chain that utilizes a unique identifier	√	✓	✓

WHAT IS TRACK AND TRACE?


Track and Trace serializes assets to:

- Track = identify where assets <u>are</u> and
- Trace = identify where assets have been


Track and Trace is the globally acknowledged standard for product movement reconciliation (Packages, Pharma, CPG) and excise tax control


Secure track and trace combines material security and information security elements to confirm assets are legitimately produced, sourced and have followed a defined path.




