RE: ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AWARD, FOR AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 170002 TO PERFORM PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION OF THE EMERGENCY VEHICLE PARKING AREA AT ROUND VALLEY AIRPORT (COVELO AREA)

## **Honorable Board Members:**

The Mendocino County Department of Transportation (DOT) received authorization, pursuant to Board Resolution Number (No.) 17-049 (April 4, 2017) to advertise for bids and award DOT Contract No. 170002, up to an estimated amount of \$40,000, for pavement reconstruction of the emergency vehicle parking area at Round Valley Airport. Bids were opened as scheduled on April 27, 2017. The lowest responsive, responsible bidder was Mendocino Construction Services, Inc., of Willits, California, with a bid of \$51,705.

Funding is available for the entire cost of the project, including the amount in excess of the original estimate, through the California Aid to Airports Program and Round Valley Airport Special Aviation Fund and will be budgeted through Budget Unit 3050 in Fiscal Year 2017/18.

I recommend and request the Board authorize and direct the Director of Transportation to award, for an amount greater than previously authorized, DOT Contract No. 170002, to Mendocino Construction Services, Inc., for the amount of \$51,705 to reconstruct the Emergency Vehicle Parking Area at Round Valley Airport.

DOT staff personnel have prepared a draft Resolution which provides said authorization for the Board's consideration and adoption.
