SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE ORDINANCE AMENDING MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 5.140, TITLE 5, - MENDOCINO COUNTY LODGING BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

This Ordinance amends Mendocino County Code Chapter 5.140, Title 5, entitled "Mendocino County Lodging Business Improvement District."

Mendocino County Code sections 5.140.030, 5.140.040 and 5.140.060 are amended to update definitions, to change all references for reporting assessment revenue to a fiscal year instead of a calendar year, and to reflect Resolution No. 15-096 which, pursuant to written protests submitted, removed the City of Point Arena from the Mendocino County Lodging Business Improvement District.

Sections 5.140.210, 5.140.240 and 5.140.250 are amended to clarify and modify the roles of the designated contractor and the Mendocino County Lodging Association and modify how both the assessment and administrative fee are handled.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on June 6, 2017.

A complete copy of the ordinance is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the Public Records Act.
