## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-070**

RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO SIGN CONTRACTS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE PROVIDED AT PRIVATE EVENTS

WHEREAS, California Government Code § 53069.8 allows a county board of supervisors to contract on behalf of the Sheriff to provide supplemental law enforcement services to private individuals and private entities in order to preserve the peace at special events or occurrences that happen on an occasional basis; and

WHEREAS, throughout each year within the County of Mendocino, a number of private events occur in which a determination is made that law enforcement services are desired at a private event; and

WHEREAS, such agreements are permissible only when the provision of services pursuant to such an agreement will not reduce the normal and regular ongoing service that the County would otherwise provide if the County did not enter into an agreement for supplemental law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, services provided pursuant to any contract made pursuant to section 53069.8 must be rendered by regularly appointed full-time peace officers, as defined in Section 830.1 of the California Penal Code, unless no regularly appointed full-time peace officers available to fill the positions as required in the contract, in which case services provided may be rendered by Level I reserve peace officers, as defined in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) of Section 830.6 of the Penal Code, who are authorized to exercise the powers of a peace officer, as defined in Section 830.1 of the Penal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Sheriff of the County of Mendocino shall be authorized to sign agreements made pursuant to California Government Code § 53069.8(a)(1), in which the value of the services provided is less than \$25,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT said agreements shall be entered into only when services provided will not reduce the normal and regular ongoing service that the County would otherwise provide if the County did not enter into an agreement for supplemental law enforcement services, and shall contain a clause that provides as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, COUNTY may forthwith cancel the providing of services under this Agreement if the Sheriff concludes that he has insufficient available personnel to provide the services required by this Agreement and to perform his other duties as required by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT services provided pursuant to any contract as permitted by this Resolution shall be rendered by regularly appointed full-time peace officers, as defined in Section 830.1 of the California Penal Code, unless there are no regularly appointed full-time peace officers available to fill the positions as required in the contract, in which case the services provide pursuant to any contract made as allowed by this Resolution may be performed by Level I reserve peace officers, as defined in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) of Section 830.6 of the Penal Code, who are authorized to exercise the powers of a peace officer, as defined in Section 830.1 of the Penal Code:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT said agreements shall also be approved by County Counsel, the Mendocino County Executive Office and the Risk Manager.
