SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15.12.040(B) OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE - PROHIBITED PARKING ON STATE HIGHWAY, ADDING PARAGRAPH 15.12.040(B)(3), PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE NORTH SHOULDER OF STATE ROUTE 20, FROM THE BOATYARD DRIVE INTERSECTION TO 155 FEET EAST OF THE BOATYARD DRIVE INTERSECTION (FORT BRAGG AREA)

This Ordinance amends Chapter 15.12.040(B) of the Mendocino County Code by prohibiting parking on the north shoulder of State Route 20, from the Boatyard Drive intersection to 155 feet east of the Boatyard Drive intersection. Currently, when exiting Boatyard Drive onto State Route 20, safety/visibility is impaired if vehicles are parked in the stated location.

The Ordinance shall become operative upon approval by a majority vote of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, and Caltrans posting the required signs.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on August 1, 2017.

A complete copy of the ordinance is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the Public Records Act.
