Current Trends

Overall, market remains strong; timing for new CCEs is good

2017 will see some tightening due to PG&'s proposed rate reduction, increase in PCIA, and competition for carbon free resources

Regulatory focus on PCIA/exit fee reform and fair implementation of SB 350 integrated resource planning provision – CPUC is a mixed bag for CCE

Growing number of CCEs will yield greater market share, greater market power and opportunities for joint action and cost sharing among CCE programs

The market (and its participants) is expanding and evolving. This is a good thing!



The Path Forward: Program Options

What options are being considered by the County?

- Join an existing CCE program (such as Sonoma Clean Power)
- Form a stand-alone CCE program that includes the county and interested cities

Option A: Outsource program funding and operations (similar to Humboldt County) Option B: Form a new JPA that is locally funded and operated (similar to San Mateo County)

• Consider an operational partnership with City of Ukiah Electric Utility
