I would like to express my support for Hannah Nelson's public comment letter as she has an excellent understanding of the state regulations, the needs of cannabis industry professionals, and how the regulations are going to effect them.

I also strongly support Patrick Sellers' letter. Specifically the points about micro-businesses as well as allowing all non-cultivation activities in Commercial zoning as well as other agricultural zoning.

Please remember that the state is considering a micro-business as a farm under 10,000 sq. ft. Please consider that our largest permitted cultivation area is considered a Micro-Business under the state guidelines. In order for us to remain competitive throughout the state, we need to be able to play with the big guys, not be regulated down to where everyone in Mendocino county is considered a "small player" by state standards.
